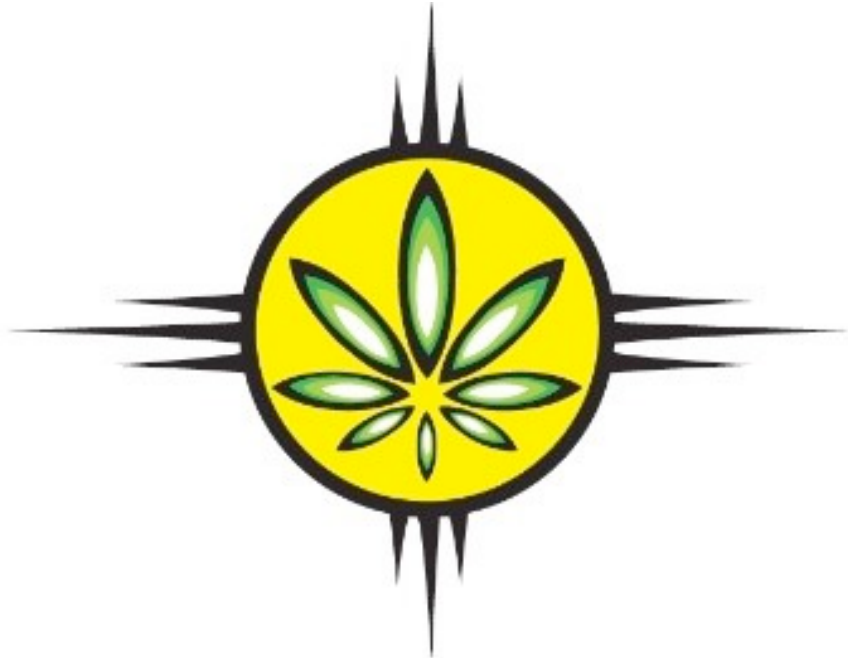

Kelowna is third in our series of national Indigenous conferences, which began at The Tsuut'ina Grey Eagle Resort, before moving to the Ottawa Convention Centre. Our programming has been an overwhelming success in creating dialogue, leading to the founding of the AFN Chief's Committee on Cannabis. We have provided an education source to over 700 First Nation, Metis, and Inuit Chiefs, Council Members, Health, Safety & EcDev Officers, and Community Members from across the country.

NICHC set new standards in the spring, by being the first cannabis and hemp conference in the country to host both The Honourable Minister of Health Ginette Petitpas Taylor, and The Honourable Bill Blair, Minister of Border Security & Organized Crime Reduction. NICHC has also been successful in featuring prominent Indigenous medical, legal & policy speakers who have proven themselves in the cannabis & hemp industries. Our objective in Kelowna is to provide an actual blueprint for Nations and Communities seeking answers to their questions on social responsibility, harm reduction, and economic development.

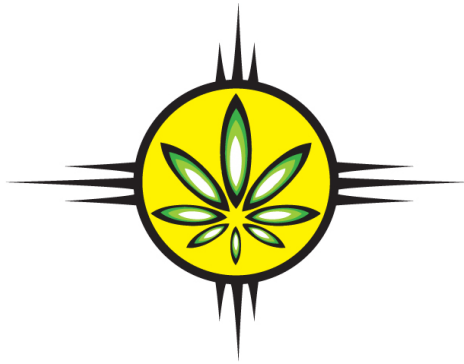
